It is not an exhaustive summary of an established science of signs, but rather an analytically sharp series of pithy explorations of concepts (mostly oppositional), which Barthes thought essential to the development of semiology as a science, namely: language/speech; signifier/signified; syntagn/system; and connotation/metallanguage.

Barthes follows up on the school of semiotics established by Ferdinand de Saussure for whom the building blocks of semiotics are found in a dyadic model of: (1) the signified; 'the "something" which is meant by the person who uses the sign' (Barthes1967: 43); (2) the signifier; the mediator which is used to infer the signified; and together they constitute the sign. Therein, one can infer the signified upon interacting with the signifier.

Barthes is one of the leading theorists of semiotics, the study of signs. He is often considered a structuralist, following the approach of Saussure, but sometimes as a poststructuralist. A sign, in this context, refers to something which conveys meaning - for example, a written or spoken word, a symbol or a myth.

Barthes takes on "complex systems" meaning those that involve cinema or any elaborate semiotic system. He critiques Jung's archetypes by analyzing them as a set of social substratums recorded in a timeless framework.
