Quarantine - Notes either a mandatory self-quarantine or mandatory quarantine in a government-designated facility is required. Covid Testing - Requires COVID-19 testing requirement before departure, or upon arrival. Health Screening - Includes temperature checks or symptom checks either before departure, or upon arrival.

Follow CDC guidelines for restricting access to health care workers and confirm that the health care worker does not have a fever by taking each healthcare worker's temperature upon arrival. Provide care to patients with known or suspected COVID-19 in a single-person room.

All close contacts should follow a 14-day quarantine period. CDC recommends that close contacts be PCR-tested for COVID-19. Even if the result is negative, these contacts should continue to quarantine for a full 14 days after last exposure and monitor for symptoms; infection could develop at any time during the quarantine period.
