Admission Requirements. To be eligible for admission to the department, applicants must: Have earned, or be in the process of earning, a Bachelor of Science degree in engineering, physics, or a comparable science program. Please note that students who have completed, or are currently enrolled in, a program leading to a Master's in Mechanical Engineering or a closely related field, or an international degree equivalent to a U.S. Master's degree, are not eligible to apply to the MSME program.
